Each candidate must be nominated on the appropriate nomination paper obtainable during normal business hours from Friday 23 July 2010 from the following locations:

Nominations of candidates must be in the hands of the electoral officer or an electoral official from the respective territorial authority at an address shown above not later than 12 noon, Friday 20 August 2010.

Each nomination must be accompanied by a deposit of \$200 GST inclusive (payable by cash, cheque or eftpos).

A candidate may submit a candidate profile statement with their nomination paper for inclusion with the voting documents being sent to electors. An attachment to the nomination paper outlines rules and procedures governing candidate profile statements.

The Waitakere and Wiri Licensing Trusts have resolved under regulation 31 of the Local Electoral Regulations 2001 to adopt the pseudo-random order of candidate names to appear on the voting documents for Waitakere and Wiri Licensing Trusts only. Candidate names will be randomly drawn out of a hat by a Justice of the Peace on 21 August 2010 at 10 am at the offices of Independent Election Services Ltd, Level 8, 92 Albert Street, Auckland. Any person is entitled to attend.
